

The safety of students while here at Pali Institute is our number one priority. We will always be following the guidance issued by the San Bernardino County Health Department and American Camp Association (ACA). Please understand this is a living document; as things are changing daily, we will be changing as needed. If guidelines or restrictions loosen or tighten, we will follow suit.

COVID Testing/Screening

- Pali strongly recommends schools to require proof of a negative COVID19 test for each student 3-days (72 hours) before the arrival date for both vaccinated and unvaccinated students attending the trip.
- Schools will be required to take the temperature of every student attending Pali prior to leaving school for camp.
- Pali Institute Staff are fully vaccinated and will also be screened for temperature and symptoms on arrival days of their assigned school.
- The Pali Institute Infirmary has rapid COVID19 tests available for students or staff showing questionable symptoms.

Masks

- Masks will be required while in the dining hall away from the assigned tables.
- If weather requires any activity to be moved indoors, masks will be required.
- Masks are not required while students are in their assigned cabins however bunks are 4 feet apart and students will sleep head to foot (heads 6ft apart).
- If a school would like to **increase** mask requirements to match school policy, please notify your VSC so that we can accommodate.

Cleaning and Hygiene

- We have increased our already thorough sanitization standards to exceed recommendations by the CDC.
- Cabins and classrooms are sanitized daily and deep cleaned after each visit.
- The dining hall is sanitized 3 times daily.
- All activities will take place outdoors; weather permitting.
- Hand washing will be required before meals and after using the restroom as well as encouraged throughout the day as much as possible.

Limiting Interactions

- Each school will have an assigned section of the dining hall.
- Cabins and classrooms are assigned to schools and used only by those students
- Classroom materials and other equipment are sanitized after each use.

*Pali Institute has 24-hour nurses on site, a dedicated wellness center, and separate entrances for those feeling sick and those taking medications. We are equipped with an isolation room for anyone showing questionable symptoms as well as full PPE.
